

Creationism built on solid base

Dear Editor:

When the Vista Unified School Board held its first meeting on Dec. 10, 1992 after the 1992 elections, John Ljubenkov, Senior Taxonomist, challenged the board with a fossilized sea shell, asking, "Do any of the board members have plans to sweep the truth of this little shell (that it is millions of years old) under the rug?"
